



JULY 1, 2010 was reported that Indonesia's export value in May 2010 reached U.S. \$ 12.52 billion or increased 4.06 percent compared with the value of exports in April 2010 and during the period from January to May 2010, Indonesia had enjoyed a trade surplus of U.S. \$. 8.85 billion.

In April 2010, the IMF forecasted that world economic growth at 4.2 percent, this figure is then raised again to 4.6 percent.
