CONTRIBUTION OF CHEMICAL SUB-SECTOR INDUSTRY for the growth of manufacturing sector / processing industry is quite big. Chemical sub-sector industry that produces raw materials, semi finished and finished product are very much in the role of supporting other sub-sector of industries.

For non-oil industrial sectors, chemical industries are classified into Industry for Fertilizer Products, Chemicals and Rubber. Sub-sectors of these industries which according to the details of the GDP (current price) have value in 2009 that stood at IDR 162,658.1 billion, or the third-largest after Food, Beverages and Tobacco Industries as well as Equipment Machinery and Transportation Equipment industries. The contribution of this manufacturing sector to Indonesia's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the largest so far.

The increase of domestic consumption for chemical industry products during 2005-2009 period had contributed to the growth of local chemical industry. When in 2005 the value of GDP reached Rp. 76213.6 billion, in 2009 its value increased to Rp. 162,658.1 billion, or twice more. This also means that the chemical industry in Indonesia has been progressing well and will continue to grow in the future.
